Football - Circus



Fritz Walter Museum, Enkenbach-Alsenborn

Football history is brought to life in the Fritz Walter Museum. The former residence of Fritz Walter at 104, Leininger Street in Enkenbach-Alsenborn breathes the spirit of the football legend. Trophies and cups give an account of victories gained, and photos with many celebrities document: "Our" Fritz was one of the great. Visitors cannot help but be filled with awe and respect for the singular athletic and human achievements of Fritz Walter.

Circus museum and Artists Spectacle, Enkenbach-Alsenborn

Come right in and take a look at what may be the smallest circus in the world, the circus museum "Bajasseum". In Herbert Guth's very detailed circus model you will see daring trapeze artists, funny clowns, fast horses, dangerous lions and huge elephants performing their acts, supported by blaring original circus music. Plus you will learn a few things about the circus tradition and the famous circus families of Alsenborn. Widespread poverty in the 19th century brought them to wander through the country as musicians, puppet players and acrobats. This tradition will be called to mind by fire-eaters, magicians and performers at the Artists Spectacle on 24 and 25 June 2006.



Mehlinger Heide, Mehlingen

The Mehlinger Heide emerged by chance, but is now intentionally preserved. Such a heathland, which has developed at a former military training area and covers roughly one and a half square miles, is not typical at all for the Palatinate. Today this largest heath in southern Germany is a nature reserve and a habitat for countless species of animals and plants in rare biotopes. They can be discovered from trails dotted by information boards. Late August to early September, when the heather is in full bloom, is the most beautiful time for a visit.

Tour with a night watchman, Otterbach

In Otterbach you can discover hidden corners of the past on a tour with a night watchman. The historic-culinary evening walk will send a chill down your spine, before you sit down for a three-course meal.
