Guided Tours of the Town and Fortifications

Register in advance to take a trip back in time showing the construction of the last major fortification of the 19th Century. The guided tour includes underground tunnels and illustrations of the life of the soldiers and civilian population 150 years ago. Qualified guides explain the imposing fortifications in various languages.

Boat Trips on the Old Rhine

Enjoy a voyage in a group (max. 24 persons) through the protected natural landscape of the meadows of the Rhine. Rare birds and untouched ancient landscapes provide an extraordinary adventure, which you can experience close-up during this two-hour trip.



Town and Fortifications Museum in the Ludwigstor (Stadt- und Festungsmuseum)

The Town and Fortifications Museum features an extensive collection of local history covering more than 1 500 m² (43 rooms). It documents the history of the town as well as the former fortifications and the garrison. There are also presentations of the civilian professions of the time, e.g. fishing on the Rhine, tobacco processing, schnapps distilling, shoemaking and the production of enamel signs – once an important industry for Germersheim.

German Road Museum in the Zeughaus (Deutsches Straßenmuseum)

A 5 000m² exhibition documents the history of road building. Under the title "From the Footpaths of the Ancients to the High-Tech Highways of the Modern Age" you can discover everything about road-, bridge-, tunnel and highway construction, archaeological road building finds and much more. A variety of special exhibitions on every aspect of roads complete the experience. If you have children, register in advance to allow them to experience these topics through games and play.



Other Excursions

The Rhine plain is not just known among insiders as a paradise for cyclists. Unspoilt natural scenery is certainly an attraction but there are also many interesting sights and tourist destinations along the well-signposted cycle tracks. Germersheim has a beautiful town centre as well as the fortifications and is perfect for shopping, wandering and whiling away the hours. Give your soul a break in the small, friendly street cafes. We also offer trips in horse-drawn carriages, trips on the Rhine and other tourist activities.
