Culture-Tour Zweibrücken



Castle and Ducal Suburb

Once the dukes of Zweibrücken had their residence in the city's heart. Today the Higher Regional Court of appeal is based in the castle. The "Schlossplatz", the square in front of the castle is a popular location for open-air events. Some of the few buildings, which have outlasted the Second World War are the public authority buildings on the "Herzogsplatz". The tourist information is also located on these antique premises.

City Museum: „Stanislaus Leszczyński- A King in Exile“

The City Museum in the „Herzogstraße“ features a special exhibition, showing the European dimension of the years the Polish King Stanislas spend in exile in the dukedom of Palatinate-Zweibrücken and in Wissembourg, Loan collection art works from German, French and Polish museums give a vivid picture of the baroque era.

Stallion's Depot and Racetrack

The stallion's depot was founded in 1755 by duke Christian IV and with its two indoor riding halls and several stables it's a major attraction for horse-lovers from miles around. Several times a year interesting horse and breed shows are presented at these premises.

Elegant animals, hectic start prearrangements and an exciting goal running-in... – but not only quadrupeds lap along the nearby racetrack. Once a year engines are revved up at the International Motorcycle Grass Track Race.

Rose Garden

The beautiful park in the middle of the city was inaugurated by the Bavarian Princess Hildegard in 1914. Today "Europe's Rose Garden" with more than 60,000 rose bushes in 2,000 varieties is a true highlight for every hobby gardener. Over the years the park was extended several times. However the rose park is not only a botanical garden. Various cultural events take place in these charming surroundings.

“Fasanerie” and Wild Rose Garden

The old castle and the Ruins of Tschifflick were once the pleasure palace of the Polish king Stanislas Leszczyński. Today the romantic hotel “Fasanerie” is built on this terrain. The wild rose garden nearby is an additional highlight next to the hotel facilities. There you can explore the biodiversity of pure wild roses. From the “European Rose Garden” you can reach the wild rose garden following the 2.5 km sign-posted rose walking track.
